

1. It is best to slaughter one's animal with one's own hands.

2. If a person is unable to slaughter it himself, he should at least be present at the time of slaughter.

3. It is mustahab (preferable) to sharpen the knife before placing the animal to lie down so that the animal does not suffer while being sacrificed.

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The Masnun Method of Udhiyah (Sacrifice)

4. One should place the animal to lie on its left side and face it towards the qiblah. Point its feet towards the qiblah. Place one's right foot on its shoulder and quickly slaughter it with a sharp knife.

5. Make the intention for 'uḍḥiyah (sacrifice) at the time of slaughtering it. (Having the intention in the heart is sufficient. It is not necessary to

verbalize the intention.) 6. Recite: بِسْمِ اللهِ أَكْبَر [Bismillāhi Allāhu Akbar] (In the name of Allāh, Allāh is the Greatest) before slaughtering the animal.

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7. Reciting the following verses [with an addition from the hadīth] while slaughtering is also established:

إِنِّي وَجَّهْتُ وَجْهِيَ لِلَّذِيْ فَطَرَ السَّمَوَاتِ وَالأَرْضَ عَلَى مِلَّةِ إِبْرَاهِيْمَ حَنِيْفًا وَمَا أَنَا مِنَ الْمُشْرِكِيْنَ إِنَّ صَلَاتِيْ وَنُسُكِيْ وَمَحْيَاىَ وَمَمَاتِيْ لِلَٰهِ رَبِّ الْعَالَمِيْنَ لاَ شَرِيْكَ لَهُ وَبِذٰلِكَ أُمِرْتُ وَأَنَا مِنَ الْمُسْلِمِيْنَ.

Translation: I have turned my face towards

Him Who created the heavens and the earth, upon the way of Ibrahim, sincerely, and I am not one of the polytheists. My prayer, my sacrifice, my life, and my death are all for Allāh, the Lord of the Universe, who has no partner. That is what I was commanded to do, and I am one of the Muslims.

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8. After slaughtering the animal, [one may] supplicate in the following manner:

ٱللهم تقبّل مِنْى كَمَاتَقَبَّلْتَ مِنْ حَبْبِكَ مُحَمَّدٍ ﷺ وَمِنْ خَلِبْلِكَ إِبْرَاهِيْمَ عَلَيْهِمَا السَّلَامُ.

Translation: O Allāh! Accept it from

me as You accepted from Your beloved Muhammad عليه and from Your Khalīl (Friend) Ibrāhīm السَّلَامُ

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
